

BRIEF BIO DR. JORGE CARRANZA DEL RIO 2022

Dr. Jorge Carranza del Rio is a specialist in pediatric neurology and neurorehabilitation with special interest in children and adults with cerebral palsy and movement disorders.

Dr. Carranza graduated as Medical Doctor by Universidad La Salle, trained as a Pediatrician at Hospital Infantil de Mexico Federico Gómez and sub-specialized in Pediatric Neurology at Centro Médico Nacional 20 de Noviembre ISSSTE by the Universidad Nacional Autónoma de México. He successfully completed a two-year fellowship on Pediatric Neurorehabilitation at Texas Scottish Rite Hospital for Children / University of Texas Southwestern Medical Center in Dallas

Dr. Carranza has co-authored four papers in peer-reviewed journals and two book chapters, related to the assessment and treatment of spasticity and dystonia in children.

Dr. Carranza del Río coordinates the Motor Control and Neuromuscular Disease Clinics at the Celaya Rehabilitation Center APAC since 2007 in Mexico. He is assistant professor in the Medical School at the Universidad Latina in Celaya and has been Professor in three different Physical Therapy University programs. He has also been a principal investigator in multicentric clinical research on pediatric neurological rehabilitation.

Dr. Carranza has had the honor to be the President of the Mexican Academy for Cerebral Palsy and Neurodevelopmental Disorders and is an active member of the Mexican Child Neurology society, American Academy of Cerebral Palsy and Developmental Disorders, American Academy of Neurology and European Academy of Childhood Disability and just recently Member at Large for the International Alliance of Academies of Childhood Disability.
